This German photographer just gets better with age. The Whitechapel's four-decade survey – the first in London – includes a mix of old favourites, such as his Stern (stars) series (1989-92) taken by a telescope at the European Southern Observatory

in Munich and L'Empereur series (1982) in which Ruff is shown slumped in a chair in progressively outlandish positions, as well as more recent work, including photographs from his Negatives series (2014) and his pro++++ series, begun in 2015, which recontextualises archival photographs from US newspapers. Also on show at the Whitechapel is a new commission by the Portuguese artist Leonor Antunes. **ES**

Living in a (post)-internet (art) world

Seth Price circa 1981

Seth Price's practice has ranged far and wide, taking in painting, sculpture, performance, writing and music. For Documenta 13 in 2012, the New York-based artist teamed up with the fashion designer Tim Hamilton to show and sell a line of white, military-inspired garments lined in corporate logos. In 2015, he published the novella *Fuck Seth Price*, about an unnamed painter-protagonist who disappears

from the art world and murders people at random. As an early adopter of digital imagery who has released much of his work online, Price is perhaps best known, however, as part of the hazy category of "post-internet art". For his first UK solo show, which focuses on more than 20 years of film and video, Price has handed curatorial control to the Institute of Contemporary Arts. According to the show's organisers, the aim is to address nothing less than our image-saturated internet age. **A.M.**
